It leads, as Lenin anticipated in his April Theses, to the immediate exit from the First World War and the collectivisation of land

Implemented in October 1917 by Lenin and Trotsky, leaders of the Bolshevik party

Russia is renamed USSR (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics)

COMMUNIST REVOLUTION

On the death of Lenin, Stalin takes power

1919: the Third International, also known as the Comintern, is established

An oppressive and ferocious dictatorship is established

In many European countries, leftists try to emulate the Russian Revolution, giving rise to the "Biennio Rosso"

Communist Parties are founded throughout Europe

Political opponents are persecuted and deported to the gulags

The Italian Communist Party is founded in Livorno in 1921

Investment is made in industrial development through the five-year plans

The Soviet Union becomes a major economic and military power
